Players by Team Type

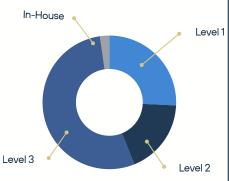
Total registered players In-House based on play level of team

In-House: 6.9%

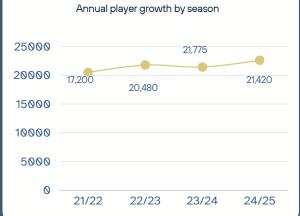
Level 3: 47.8%



Players by Age Level

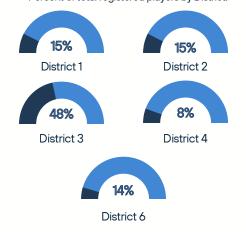


Player Growth
